# Sandia Ranger District Forest Closures Starting Monday June 30, 2008

**Albuquerque, June 27, 2008** –Beginning June 30, 2008 at 8:00 am, **ALL** of the Sandia Ranger District on the Cibola National Forest will be in Stage III restrictions.

### **REGULATIONS/RESTRICTIONS**

- > No Hiking/Biking/No Motorized Vehicles allowed in back-country areas and on trails.
- > No Campfires/No Charcoal/No Stoves (Cold Picnics Only).
- Smoking in vehicles only.
- > Fire works are NEVER allowed on your National Forests.

## **OPEN RECREATION SITES**: The following Picnic areas are open

- > Doc Long, Sulphur Canyon, Balsam Glade, and Upper Capulin Picnic Areas on the east side.
- > Jaun Tabo and La Cueva Picnic areas on the west side.
- > Pine Flat Picnic Ground and Cedro Group Reservation Site Campground south of I-40.
- Sandia Ranger District Administrative Site, Tijeras Pueblo Interpretive Trail and climbing area next to the district office.

#### **OPEN TRAILS**:

- Portions of Forest Trail 365, including secondary trails associated with Forest Trail 365, outside of the Sandia Mountain Wilderness (Foothills Trails).
- Sandia Peak Ski Area is open for hiking and biking within the ski area boundary only.
- > All other trails are closed including La Luz Trail.

#### **OPEN ROADS**

- ➢ Forest Roads 445, 413, and 242
- > Forest Roads 333,333B, 333C, and 333D to La Cueva and Juan Tabo Cay use areas
- ➢ Forest Road 252 to Cedro Campground

#### **OPEN AREAS:**

Sandia Crest Observation Area, Sandia Peak Tram and associated facilities and Sandia Crest House (Smoking is allowed ONLY in the posted designated smoking area at the Sandia Peak Tram and Sandia Crest House
